REGISTRATION FOR THE 2019-2020 SCHOOL YEAR

If you have a child who will begin school next year, pass by Pierre De Coubertin School during Registration Week from **February 3- 7** from 8:00 am-12:00 pm and 2:30-3:30 pm. **Wednesday, February 5th** we will also offer extended hours from 4:00-6:00 pm. If you already have a child enrolled in our school, the siblings are not automatically registered.

Parents must bring with them:

- *The child's birth certificate (long version) showing the names of mother and father
- * The Certificate of Eligibility of an older brother/sister or parent. Along with the birth certificate (long version) of the parent who went to English school.
- *Child's vaccination booklet.
- *Child's Medicare card
- *Parents Social Insurance Number
